## c. **GREENACRE GARAGE**

21/03484/FUL - Change of use of existing vehicle workshop to retail E(b), expansion of area

of the existing retail facility and cessation of use of existing vehicle workshop. Retention of existing fuel station and provision of managers flat within existing first floor area To note that Cheshire West and Chester Council have not yet been reached a decision on the Planning Application. The Planning Officer has confirmed that most of the works undertaken to date have involved the replacement of the subterranean pipework to the existing pump positions and the installation of new pumps to maintain compliance as the existing pumps were old and failing. However, whilst undertaking these works they replaced the existing totem sign with one lower in height but reflecting the new fuel supplier as per the submitted application for new signage. They have therefore carried out some work that hadn't been approved. They have been advised not to undertake any further works requiring Planning Permission or Advertisement Consent until the submitted applications have been determined.
