18/079.1 Nos 61 and 61A High Street (Previous Minute 18/063)

The Enforcement Officer had confirmed that neither a change of use or any other approval was required. The resident who made the complaint had been informed.

18/079.2 Nos 42 – 44 High Street (Previous Minute 18/064)

The Enforcement Officer had reported that express advertisement consent would, strictly speaking, be required as the advert was sited higher than the bottom level of the first-floor window in the wall on which the advertisement was displayed. However, on the basis that no changes were to be made to the sign and that no further advertisements were displayed on the property, Cheshire West and Chester Council did not consider it expedient to take matters any further. The meeting noted that Reades had been advised accordingly and had been informed that if further adverts were displayed then Cheshire West would have to review their position.

18/081 KING GEORGE V PLAYING FIELD

18/081.1 Drainage

The work had been carried out between 26th and 28th June.

18/081.2 Condition of the Field

The vertidraining (scheduled for 11th July) and spraying work (scheduled for 18th July) had been postponed as the ground had been too hard due to the lack of rain.

18/081.3 Green Waste Bin (children's play area)

RESOLVED: that the green waste bin be removed as it did not have a lid and as a result animals/birds were removing the contents of the bin and leaving them on the ground.

18/081.4 Annual External Inspection of Play Equipment

The Annual Inspection had been scheduled for early August and would be carried out by Morral Play Services.

18/082 SECTION 106 FUNDING

Cheshire West and Chester Council and Taylor Wimpey Ltd had both said that the suggestions from the Scout and Guide Movement were not acceptable, mainly because the items suggested would not be available to all, only those involved with Scouts and Guides. The Scout and Guide Movement had been informed and whilst disappointed they had appreciated being considered.

Councillor Twigg had obtained a new quotation of £30,000.00 plus VAT for a larger Trim Trail than previously accepted. Taylor Wimpey Ltd had indicated that they were happy with the quote. Cheshire West and Chester Council were asking for two further like for like quotations. The Clerk had indicated that whilst it was possible to obtain two further quotations like for like would not be possible as different manufacturers did not generally produce identical items. A response from Cheshire West and Chester Council was awaited.

RESOLVED: that the new quotation be approved subject to Councillor Twigg being able to confirm that there would be sufficient room between the football pitch and new equipment.

18/083 TARPORLEY HIGH SCHOOL

18/084 TRAVELLER DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Stage 2 of the programmed work on the Traveller DPD was due. The work would include a review of the revised 2018 GTAA and the DPD Issues document.

RESOLVED: that Mr Michael Stallard be asked to carry out this work on behalf of Council and if practically possible produce a draft report for the next meeting. The cost would be approximately £700 and taken from the Special Projects budget.

18/085 OVERGROWN HEDGES

RESOLVED: (18/085.1) that the Clerk write to the residents at 22 Hunters Crescent, Tarvin requesting that the hedge be cut back.

RESOLVED: (18/085.2) that the Clerk write to the residents at 1 Park Close asking for the hedge along Park Lane to be cut back.

RESOLVED: **(18/085.3)** that the clerk write to the residents of Cobweb Cottage, Cross Lanes, Oscroft asking that the hedge be cut back and that the motor vehicle not be housed on the grassed area on the corner of Cross Lanes and Willington Road.

RESOLVED: (18/085.4) that the Clerk write to the residents of Fairways, Cross Lanes, Oscroft asking for the hedge to be cut back.

18/086 FOOTPATH MAP

Councillor Ryan reported that little progress had been made. He was awaiting a response from Cheshire East Council and a meeting with a representative of Tarvin Civic Trust was planned for later in the week.

18/087 OSCROFT BENCH

Some of the timber on the bench was defective showing some significant cracks. The bench had been collected by the manufacturer on 10th July 2018 and was expected to be repaired and returned by the end of July.

RESOLVED: that articles be written on the Tarporley High School meeting, King George V Playing Field, speeding on Saxon Heath, Neighbourhood Plan, and overgrown hedges.

Rights of Way had confirmed that the determination date had moved from September 2018. A new date had not been given but it was expected to be at some point in 2019.

On 20th July the Clerk had asked one of the Streetscene Supervisors to find out why the bins had not been emptied. A response was awaited.
